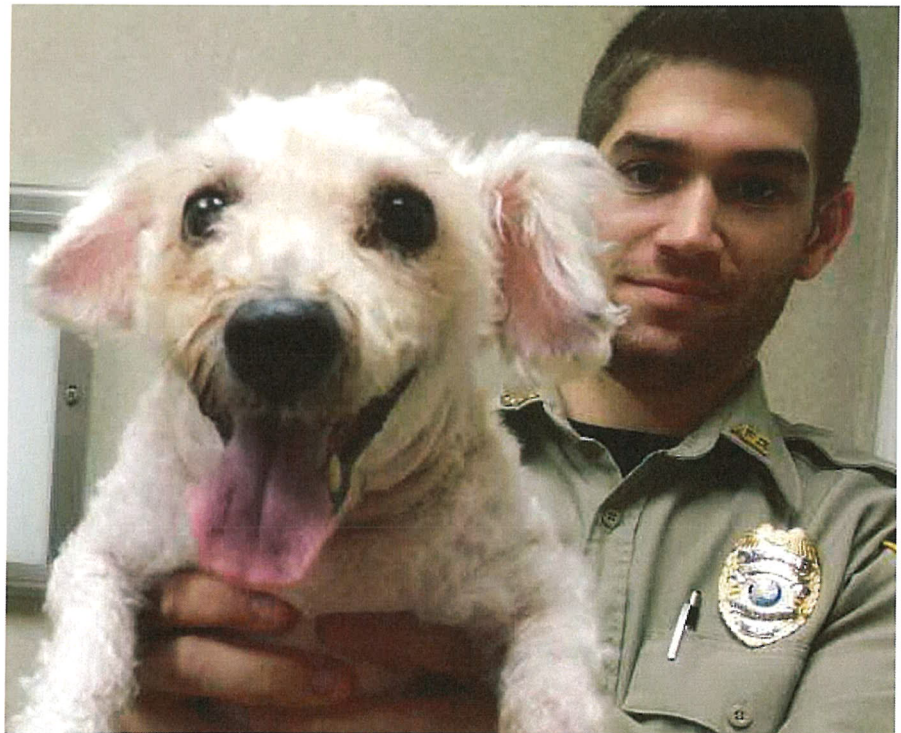


“Buddy”

He was severely underweight, flea infested and smelled of feces and urine.

After being examined by a veterinarian, groomed, and given some TLC, he was adopted into a loving home.

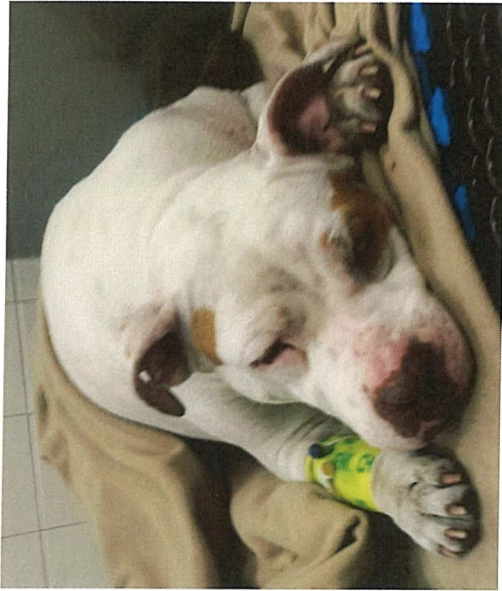

Treatment: lab work, exam, urinalysis, ultrasound, fecal, meds

Cost: \$238.18

Outcome: Adopted

“Trudy”



Trudy is a white and red pit bull that was picked up in June of 2016. The canine was lethargic, breathing heavily, and she had a strong odor coming from her urine. The dog would not eat and when she drank she was throwing up a black charcoal like substance. Trudy was immediately taken to the vet. It was determined that Trudy had a severe obstruction; a dish towel was lodged in her intestines and needed emergency surgery. Today, Trudy is healthy, doing well, and is currently up for adoption at the Animal Welfare League.

Treatment: exam, fluids, hospitalization, pain management, cytology, surgery

Cost: \$2,021.20

Outcome: As of 7/19/16 currently up for adoption

“Lilly”



“Lilly” was from a neglect case in June of 2016. After she was examined by a veterinarian, it was determined she needed an emergency spay due to Pyometra. She will be available for adoption soon!

Treatment: Emergency Spay/Pyometra

Cost: \$ 490.97
